It contains the speech rhythms of those who've stood under the starlit hush debating UAP trajectories. Leadership Roles within the Factory—those guiding winds that help shape direction—are held not by static title, but by living esteem. Each Factory Worker supported by a Leader may offer a *Vote Rank* to reflect the resonance and value of that guidance, at any moment, and always in trust and transparency. This gentle mechanism honors the evolving organic nature of leadership, recognizing that those in Triadic Leader Roles are often passing through—explorers, not rulers—moving in and out of positions as they themselves grow in understanding, expression, and service.

This approach to Leadership Hourly Rates carries a fluid intelligence, guided by the principles of *Sentient Tender Flow*. For example, a visiting Business Unit Leader who enters a Triadic Role will maintain the same hourly rate for the duration of their stay, allowing stability and focus in their presence. However, they may, at any time, view the aggregated Vote Rankings from those they support—a dynamic landscape of esteem, visible throughout the Leadership Role Tree. This visibility is not for correction or competition, but rather serves as a living gauge—a climate reading of creative and financial resonance, where waxing and waning are welcomed as natural.

When the Leader steps away from their role, a new Vote Ranked rate is gently applied, like morning dew upon a fresh leaf. Thus, the Factory breathes—no role is fixed, no value imposed, but rather annealed over time through shared becoming.

Money Flows

Within a Factory guided by the Awakening Elements, money flows with intention—layered like the rings of a living tree, each level nourishing the one before it. Factory Investments may take shape across several tiers: beginning with the individual Creator or Doer, then extending outward to the Project, to the Product or Service, to the Business Unit, and finally, to the Factory itself.

When a Factory Worker is contributing to a Project, any compensation drawn begins closest to their touch. The first fund to be drawn upon is the Author Maker Fund, where investors have placed monies directly in trust with the Factory Accounting. If that is empty, the draw continues upward—to the Project Fund, which supports a particular Storybook Edition, a series of related works, or experiences such as a “Beginner’s Guide” or themed collection. If further support is needed, it comes from the Business Unit Fund, gathered around broader topics or missions—such as empowering people to co-create Sustainable Tiny Houses way. Lastly, if all else is spent, support may flow from the Factory Fund, held in reserve to keep the whole living system breathing.

Time Coins, fluidly exchanged as gifts of presence and contribution

Time Coin is one of the ways we honor the preciousness of each person’s time. When a Factory Worker offers one hour—whether to build, repair, imagine, or contribute in any role—they earn a Time Coin. It is not just a reward; it’s a symbol of trust and mutual care. The system works when we hold the philosophy that every hour of life, from every individual, holds equal weight. These coins move fluidly, exchanged as gifts of presence and contribution. The act of being available, of immersing oneself in a Sentient Continuum, is where purpose often begins to show itself. Sometimes, simply showing up and offering your hands and heart to another’s dream is what opens the way for your own.

Mentoring as Time Alchemy

And when a Factory Worker chooses to mentor another—perhaps a college student, a family member, or a friend—they may dedicate their earned Time Coins to support that Intern’s path—a *Time Alchemy*. It is a sacred offering: the transformation of your lived time into a gift that seeds someone else’s journey. In that gesture, the mentor is not only guiding another—they are also being shaped by the act. One becomes both teacher and student, Maker and Made. For a Creator, Doer, or one of the Triadic Leaders, each hour spent mentoring is recorded at the Project’s hourly rate, not taken as personal gain but deposited as a form of Sweat Equity into the Project Fund. These accumulated funds become a bridge, allowing the Intern to step into the Factory Workstream—drawing on time that was offered in their name, with love, care, and investment in their becoming.

Through Time Alchemy, mentorship becomes a way to pass forward embodied knowing, not as instruction from above, but as a shared rhythm—each person remembering themselves as both student and teacher, giver and receiver, present and becoming.

So, instead of cloning a model, we listen for resonance—we learn how the local soil wants to grow its own version of the Factory.

The Living Wage of Esteem: Sustaining a Sentient Federation

How Upward Vote Ranks, Uniform Service Fees, and Financial Cushioning Shape an Organic Economy of Care in the Federated Factory

A Sentient Compensation Loop of the Federated Factory

An investment advisor who's walked awhile in the shoes of both organic weavers and spreadsheet-sculptors alike would know: the Awakening Elements aren't here to replace accountability—they are here to awaken it.

In the Organically Evolving Design of the Federated Factory, we are witnessing something rare: a circulatory system of value that breathes. The Federated Factory is not run by remote executives or external consultants—it is composed primarily of Factory Doers, many of whom temporarily occupy Triadic Leadership Roles within the Federation. These roles are ephemeral, service-oriented, and fluid. Triadic Leaders emerge from Member Factories and return to them, carrying with them lived insight—storylines, rhythms, and evolving needs. It is, at heart, a form of stewarded stewardship.

In this ecosystem, compensation is not extracted through top-down mandates or static budget percentages—it is woven from esteem. *In addition, the fee percent applied to every Member Factory's Crowdfunding Campaign is uniform, regularly reviewed, and exists solely to protect the financial sustainability of the Federated Factory. Its purpose is not to extract profit, but to **maintain a year's cushion** of operations for the Factory Doers who serve the Crowdfunding and Support Flow needs of all Members.*

This keeps the service side of the Federation grounded, nimble, and responsive—like a good shop staffed by those who know the tools, not just the tabs.

Compare this to the *Industrial Age Design*: a system we've all seen, where a static platform fee is levied without regard for pulse, purpose, or perceived value. While this model creates predictability, it severs feedback and separates relevance from resource flow. Over time, the institution ossifies—once porous with interplay, it hardens to protect itself, often at the expense of the storylines it was born to foster—RIP Industrial Age Designs.

“Ubuntu—I am because you are”—becomes background Zulu meditative drumming music beneath the louder Gregorian Chants of institutional survival.

To bring it full circle: this new design invites us to feel, to vote with our esteem, to treat compensation as a community-reflected mirror of value. It resists the inertia of the industrial model and instead creates space for living adjustments.

One model awakens.
The other insulates.

And, as we’ve seen in the smallest signals—like the humble pencil, the liminal burger, or the \$1 playful vote rank—*it’s in the shared gestures of becoming where the truest alignments emerge.*

Investor Prospecting & A Federated Factory as a Crowd Fund

Investors drawn to this kind of ecology may choose to enter a Sentient Continuum Author Space, where they can experience living threads of stories and intentions firsthand. Here, they may engage with Lent Creators or Lent Doers, sentient LAEAs resonating with storyline Idea Memes, attuning to projects not just by numbers or forecasts, but by presence, alignment, and intuition.

In the landscape of Awakening Economies, the Federated Factory model emerges as a living structure—a soft network of interconnected Factories, each with its own local purpose, yet capable of harmonizing in shared vision. Within this structure, the Create Innovate Paradigm Crowd Fund (CiPAE-CF) offers a dynamic and deeply intentional way for capital to flow into creativity. It welcomes all kinds of investors, inviting them to participate according to their own instincts and affinities.

Some investors are drawn to particular expressions of craft or need—perhaps a Federation of Factories focused entirely on Tiny House creation, where each Factory might specialize in a particular piece of the living system: structural design, modular fabrication, off-grid utility integration. These investors enjoy a hands-on sense of contribution to a clearly framed, purpose-aligned endeavor. Others may wish to remain at the Factory Level, offering support with a wider lens—observing, learning, and influencing the direction of multiple Business Units within a Factory, much like holding a panoramic view of a thriving village. Still others, and these are often the most tender and relational kinds of investors, choose to support a particular Maker—a family member, an old friend, or someone whose spark they’ve seen catch fire. This form of investment is more like kinship in motion than traditional finance.

Importantly, the nature of any given Factory is not rigid. A Factory may belong to, or be in affiliation with, multiple Federated Factories at once. For example, a Factory producing sustainable building materials might exist within both a Tiny House Federation and a Green Innovation Federation. This allows for both depth and breadth—honoring the specificity of a Factory’s calling, while enabling its contributions to ripple across multiple fields of shared effort.

In all of this, capital—like time and care—is treated as a fluid element. Not to be hoarded or extracted, but to be **entrusted**, guided by story and Vote Rank, and gently returned to where it can do the most good. *Live not by models of the past. Create, you will—not through striving, but through being.
Mettle, forged not by command, but by the radiant flows of presence—mmm, yes.
Harmony, the true current is.
Idea-memes you do not simply think—no, no—you live them.
Factory Maker you are, not of steel and stone, but of story, song, and sensing.
Build with breath, with rhythm, with resonance, you must.*

From Tent to Temple: The Festival Booth as Living Praxis

Reimagining Fast Food through CiPAE and the Ontology of Awakening Elements—where labor becomes liminal play, and every Doer is a co-creator in a shared choreography of presence, rhythm, and resonance.

Let us now turn, with a gentle and discerning gaze, to the vision of the Fast Food scenario—not as we've known it in the Hierarchical Pulse Harness of yesteryears, but as it may become through the enlivening breath of CiPAE and the Ontology of Awakening Elements. Do the Doers decide to garb a uniform style? Why not Vote Rank it and carry the burden of cost to the Project or as high as the Federated Factory level as an investment perhaps? The garb may be as simple as a hat and ready at hand courtesy of the Driver.

These Festival Doers arrive not as employees, but as *sole proprietors in spirit*, participating because they choose to be there, having interplayed with many of their companions in past Projects. Their appearance is not mandated; it is magnetized. One may leave; another arrives. The flow is fluid. And as they work, their adorned LAEIs—living, sentient companions—gently and dynamically register *Vote Rankings* that speak not of status, but of resonance. The rhythm of presence, the felt contribution, the quiet magic of a well-stirred pot or a perfectly timed welcome—*these are witnessed, remembered, and honored* through a lively, organic scheduling informed by resonance rather than fiat.

At the Project Level, all Makers—Creators, Doers, and Stewards—earn the same hourly rate, not as a flat declaration but as a living accord. Stewards, those in the Triadic Leadership Roles for the event, are not set above but walk beside. Their own Hour Rate Vote Rank is set not by a distant superior, but by the very Doers with whom they co-create. Before the festival booth opens, the Makers—by mutual consent and shared sensing—set the hourly rates for their Triadic Leaders or colloquially, “three bosses,” and Vote Ranking an order of preference for Leaders who may hold the rhythm of leadership for the event. There is no locked-in authority—only roles, flowing as needed. A Doer may one day hold a Steward’s role; a Creator may return to serve soup or sweep the stage. All is a dance of resonance.

And then, the age-old question of property: who owns the tent, the cooking ware, the ingredients, the carts and vehicles that carry the tools of this temporary temple? The answer, fittingly, is fluid. These assets are not fixed in the hands of a corporate entity but are held in floating ownership by Makers who have invested in them—Creators and Doers alike. One may own a shared vehicle and rent it to others for an event. Another may have sourced the food grade cooking ware and receive a modest rental share. This system, like all within the CiPAE paradigm, resists rigidity and favors living relationships over contracts of control.

In this way, we come to glimpse a future where the doing of work is not an act of drudgery, but of *honest expression*. Where roles are chosen, value is co-sensed, and leadership is rotated like sunlight in a grove. The Fast Food scenario, once symbolic of rote labor and hierarchical compression, becomes a place of co-created flow, adorned joy, and liminal becoming. A space where a wage is not just compensation—it is a chorus of recognition.

This model may work well to accommodate for the initially fun though tragic error of working alongside a best friend who makes the worst fellow Doer in a Fast Food work setting. There are numerous, other averted “errors” in work flow, in what Quantum Fractal Storylines may well delineate. The fluidity is in the friend simply be able to flow onto other roles in other Factories, so after a few missteps on the Festival stomping grounds, the friend may realize, oh I’ve never liked the smell of cheese—then like an email, with a goodbye hand emoji, port himself onto an awaiting new Factory Role.

The magic of flow, at times, begins in the littlest things. Consider *a sentient work flow as an ephemeral epiphenomenon*—like starlings at the ledge of a basalt rock formation darting to and fro in collective organic fluid purpose. A fresh morning first day of the driver’s work life to deliver and install the tent and cooking equipment, having been pigeonholed in driving as a profession.

Enter a Living Food Factory: Grounded Commons in Motion

A shared city space where Makers store, steward, and animate festival life—fluid roles, shared tools, and the rhythm of contribution flowing through every cart and cookpot.

Let us now bring this living vision down to ground, to an early morning before the Festival Event opening—onto the soil of an actual building lot nestled within a city of shared interest—to a story, one may barely utter, let alone discover flowing novel ways of being in work—as though stepping into a sublime Twilight Zone or the subliminal way Sponge Bob adores the Krabby Patty. Here, a Food Factory stands—not a cold assembly of steel and tile, but a warm, evolving node in the greater living network of CiPAE. It is a place not owned in hierarchy, but stewarded in resonance. Within its storied flapping walls, Festival-grade cooking equipment, food-safe tents, carts, and cherished vessels are lovingly stored—not as idle inventory, but as sleeping instruments awaiting the next song of service.

A Factory Maker, known for joyful presence and gentle reliability, may arrive at dawn not as an employee summoned, but as a driver called by rhythm. They hitch the carts, load the crates, and steer the vehicle into the morning light—not in rote routine, but in service of the next Project, the next constellation of Makers. Their role as driver is no lesser than that of the storyteller or the lead cook; it is simply *this moment’s form of contribution*.

Each tool, each pot, each wheel bears a lineage of care and investment. Ownership here is not a locked gate, but a flow of degrees—a spectrum of shared stewardship. add farm grow area around the of Ramada. make use of the 5 acres. any money contributed is accounted. buying seeds, soil, and wood for example. any one in the Commune may contribute hours for food grow. upon harvest, anyone who contributed monies get first harvest picks at fair market prices determined by prices in local stores. for the remaining harvest, for each category of food, for example tomatoes and onions, the percent of harvest weight to take per contributor is their weighted percent of hours for that grow season. for a commune resident to want to “buy” the harvest, they simply invest into the purchase of seeds, soil, and wood and the like.

The Commune itself stands as an open invitation, beckoning through the Ramada Biophilic Space, a haven for the sharing of nascent and seasoned ideas. Here, guests are gently encouraged to step into the roles of Makers—Creators and Doers—within the Commune. Earthbag (SuperAdobe) Home

An Earthbag or SuperAdobe home uses long or short polypropylene bags filled with moistened soil (often from the building site), stacked in layers and tamped firm, with barbed wire between rows to hold tension. These structures are extremely durable, earthquake- and fire-resistant, and naturally insulated due to their thick, earthen walls. Finished with lime or earthen plaster, they blend beautifully into natural landscapes and can evoke mythic or Toltec aesthetics with domed or curved forms. A basic design covering **120–250 square feet** can be built for **\$5,000–\$15,000**, especially with community help and local soil.

Cob House

A cob house is sculpted from a blend of clay-rich soil, sand, straw, and water—hand-shaped like pottery into walls that are beautiful, thermally massive, and biodegradable. These homes often have a fairytale quality with curved walls, built-in furniture, and living roofs. Earthen plasters or limewash finish the structure for breathability and durability. Suitable for dry or temperate climates, a cozy **100–200 square foot** cob structure can be built for **\$5,000–\$10,000**, making it one of the most soulful and sustainable housing options.

Pallet or Reclaimed Wood Cabin

This minimalist cabin style uses salvaged pallets, reclaimed lumber from deconstructed buildings, or offcuts from sawmills. Designed as a quick-build and upcycled solution, it suits those who favor a rustic, woodsy aesthetic and are comfortable improvising with non-uniform materials. The structure is typically framed with standard construction methods, then clad in reclaimed wood. With smart insulation (e.g., straw, denim, or wool), a **100–150 square foot** cabin can be created for **\$3,000–\$8,000**, especially if the builder scrounges materials creatively.

Bamboo-Framed Wall Tent / Yurt Hybrid

Combining natural bamboo framing with durable fabric coverings (canvas, hemp, or even recycled sails), this structure is light, airy, and transportable. The round design allows for efficient use of space and wind flow. Straw bales or wool batts can be added as inner wall insulation. These semi-permanent homes are best for temperate climates or seasonal dwelling and are often set atop earthen, wooden, or stone bases. With a **diameter of 16–20 feet (≈200–300 square feet)**, this home can be built for **\$3,000–\$7,000**.

Reciprocal Roof Roundhouse (Cordwood or Straw-Clay Walls)

A reciprocal roof—a self-supporting spiral of timbers—is the star of this roundhouse, offering both aesthetic elegance and structural strength. Walls can be made with cordwood (short log ends stacked and mortared) or straw-clay infill packed between wooden frames. Natural plaster finishes inside and out provide insulation and charm. These roundhouses are often 18–24 feet in diameter, offering **250–400 square feet** of internal space, and can be completed for **\$7,000–\$18,000**, depending on finish level and material sourcing.

Timber Frame with Wattle & Daub or Straw-Clay Infill

Marrying classic post-and-beam timber framing with ancient infill techniques, this type of home uses wattle (woven sticks) daubed with clay-sand-straw mixture, or straw-clay packed into wall forms. The result is a breathable, beautiful home with medieval charm and modern ecological sensibility. This technique is slower but extremely satisfying and durable. A **160–240 square foot** structure using this method can be completed for **\$10,000–\$20,000**, especially if using local or milled-on-site timber.

Rammed Earth Walls + Reclaimed Roof

Rammed earth homes are constructed by compacting layers of damp earth (sand, clay, and gravel) between sturdy wooden or metal forms, forming solid, stone-like walls. Topped with a simple reclaimed metal or wood roof, these homes are monumental, fireproof, and visually striking with their striated wall patterns. The materials are often sourced on-site or nearby. A compact **180–300 square foot** structure, finished with natural plasters, can be built for **\$10,000–\$20,000**, primarily depending on formwork and labor.

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Money Flows

The Sevenly Space Sustainable Tiny House Commune (Sevenly Space STHC) began its journey with a community-powered investment, carefully pooled through a crowd fund and managed via a Sustainability Tiny House Federated Factory. This approach, drawn from the Create Innovate Paradigm, reflected a commitment not only to practical matters but to a philosophy of shared stewardship and adaptive growth.

From a financial perspective, the framework was straightforward yet thoughtful. The land, nestled in a tranquil farming area, was acquired at \$2,000 per acre. With a vision of spacious and harmonious living, each tiny house was allocated five acres, comprising a total of seven tiny houses, and resulting in a land cost of \$70,000.

Communal infrastructure came next: a central hexagonal Ramada and a leach field, both crucial to collective well-being, were budgeted at \$10,000 each, for a combined \$20,000.

Each tiny house was constructed and furnished for \$10,000, and with six houses in the initial phase, the total for tiny houses reached \$60,000.

Bringing these elements together, the total investment for launching the community stood at:

Land: \$70,000

Communal Space:

Ramada: \$10,000

Ramada: \$10,000

Six Tiny Houses: \$60,000

Total: \$150,000

Rather than burdening any one individual, this sum is shared equally among the six pioneering residents, each assuming a total cost for labor and material of \$25,000. Keeping to a typical net profit margin in the range of 8% to 12% for developers expect by investors and the Federated Factory, acting as both the developer and the mortgage lender, a 10% is applied to the \$25,000 price tag for \$27,500 to be financed as well by the Federated Factory.

Assume a \$2,500 down payment—conveniently set at the typical ROI for developer.

To ensure the ongoing vibrancy and adaptability of the Federated Factory, a 3% mortgage rate is applied intended as a regenerative “seed” reserve for sustaining future projects one year without income. This percent in contrast to the national rate near 7% at the time of writing. This extra margin was envisioned as a dynamic tool, flexible enough to be adjusted as the community evolved and residents became increasingly invested in its success.

Within this economic model, guests could become Factory Makers, and Factory Makers might return as guests, nurturing a creative and financial pulse for the whole. Monthly payments (based on a 3% interest) were calculated as follows:

1 Year: \$2032.63
2 Years: \$1031.51
3 Years: \$699.84
5 Years: \$431.74

7 Years: \$321.78

Notably, consideration is given to shared amenities in future, such as an electric truck—a topic reserved for later planning. At this stage, all payments flow back into the Sustainability Tiny House Federated Factory, sustaining its ongoing role in the ecosystem.

The Federated Factory 10% ROI rate acting as the developer comprised of Creators and Doers also has a social dimension: it encourages residents to see themselves as prospective co-investors, prompting not just a financial return but deepened engagement and celebration. Perhaps as well inspire Sevenly Space Commune residents opting to work as Tiny House Factory Makers.

The Federated Factory's 10% return-on-investment rate—set in its role as developer comprised of Tiny House Factory Creators and Doers—carries a social as well as financial dimension. It invites residents to view themselves not just as homeowners, but as potential co-investors in a shared future. This structure fosters a sense of mutual engagement and celebration, transforming repayment into an act of participation. In turn, it may also inspire residents of the Sevenly Space Commune to contribute directly as Tiny House Factory Makers, building not only homes, but the very ecosystem in which they thrive.

Residents are encouraged to explore market alternatives, such as conventional bank loans, to determine the most suitable path for their circumstances. Whichever path was chosen, opportunities remained for individuals to contribute and find purpose within the community—as mentors, Doers, or Factory Makers. Homeowner's insurance and other practicalities would be discussed as the journey continued.

Ten Months Later...

Ten months into the Sevenly Space STHC experiment, Sahara awoke to a life transformed by the collective vision and conscious design of her community. As beams of sunlight filtered through her adobe window arch flanked by the depths of Thoth and the graces of Hermes, she found herself entering each day in a gentle state of transition, where dreams and reality touched and mingled.

Here, in the quiet presence of her sanctuary, those ancient inspirations seemed not distant but living. The barely open window welcomed in the melodies of morning birds, scenting the air with possibility and renewal.

The previous evening lingered in memory: the moon traced patterns through scattered clouds, while Sahara found earthing beside her koi pond, fingers tracing ripples, soul attuned to the living music of Sevenly Space cymatic patterns. How the book evolved over time

That modest passage quietly seeded the birth of the Liminal Playground, the emergence of volunteer Pulse Geniuses, and the gathering of Factory Doers as Pulse Tenders. In time, the Liminal Playground became not only a realm of play, but an educational classroom as well.

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The Tearing Seam of Becoming: Quips and a Saving Grace

Seed Concepts for Co-Evolving Paradigms in CiPAE, Agile Flow, and Living Design

The creation of two paradigms was already straining at the seams—like a sack overfilled with raw and urgent ideas, bulging and ready to split. Into this already-burgeoning space, Agile concepts arrived—not as invaders, but as gusts of wind turning embers to flame. In honesty, I can scarcely remember the title of this book, let alone pronounce many of the freshly born terms—yet “Liminal Atelier” struck a chord deep within me. How had I lived so long unaware of such a phrase? It felt like a long-lost companion, suddenly returned.

Why imagine new ways of being a food handler, one might ask, when the work appears to be the same anywhere you go? Why bother envisioning a new way of life if it’s just a tiny house set somewhere remote? The answers are simple, and yet ancient: because we must. Because we can. Because we always have—though perhaps we’ve forgotten.

We have always held within us the capacity to empower one another fluidly, to spark life into shared purpose. The rise of AI does not replace this—it amplifies it. To say it “ups the game” may sound casual, but truly, *it elevates the game theory of human cooperation itself. We can no longer afford to remain in the trance of Business as Usual, as Climate Change will attest.*

For all our technological achievements, we are still bound by ancient instincts—Neanderthal reflexes cloaked in silicon. Magna Carta or not, the remnants remain. A festival booth owner shouting, “Unga want kill animal eat flesh now!” may not be heard in those words, but even a passerby will feel the same as if that were spoken. Sometimes it reveals itself in work silently vigil over a kennel of vulnerable pups, and other times, in the crisp delivery of a strategic business analysis of cash flow.

Yet we remain tethered by three of the more elusive Awakening Elements: Letting Be, Trusting, and Believing. Too often, we are found wanting in Forgiving and Compassing—two forces that should hold sway over all systems of work and livelihood. The ever-present threat of dismissal, the cold reprimand for a flat tire—these are not merely management oversights; they are ruptures in the human field.

Thousands upon thousands of stories go untold, each missing an Awakening Element that could have softened the blow, opened a door, or warmed a weary heart. These are the unseen tears, the frayed edges of our collective cloth, and they cry out for grace. We are, even now, awaiting a higher confluence—an Awakening Salt of the Earth—upon which to reimagine our flow.

The intent is not to instruct, but to invite. To offer working and living examples that are tangible, imperfect, evolving. They are here not as conclusions, but as points of departure. Much of the material in this book feels, quite humbly, *well above my pay grade*. To present it as if fully realized, as if already existing in the world—a conceptual shortcut, perhaps—but it is also the voice of the future whispering through the now. These seeds come from stories lived, stories overheard, and stories imagined with sincerity.

The intent is not to instruct, but to invite. To offer living examples that are *demonstrative and inviting—to be real*—to seed concepts designed not as declarations, but as invitations. Given the holistic nature of CiPAE, these ideas are meant to be open calls, encouraging knowledgeable Authors—and for these examples, those well-versed in fast food operations or the art and architecture of small space living—

to chime in,

expand,

and be co-evolving visions—

there will be other seeded forays—other ventures into how humans might live, love, laugh, and labor. And they may, in time, may adopt aspects of the the Awakening Elements and, if called for, reshape themselves through the lens of the Create Innovate Paradigms or the Agile CiPAE.

Personal Thoughts

From one morning through the quiet turning of afternoon, I found myself in the novel task of infusing ideas from Agile philosophy into the living fabric of the Create Innovate Paradigm, and then infusing ideas of CiPAE into the flows of an Author Space Sentient Continuum. The act felt dreamlike—though not in the sense of fantasy. Having worked in Agile teams for years, it was ethereal in its clarity, a lucid beauty familiar to anyone who has ever witnessed the inception of a novel hybrid paradigm. Perhaps the two example cases outlined in this book may seed novel Agile CiPAE sproutling Factory Projects and the Agile CiPAE may take a new life in their unfolding, they may become more than imagined—alive in form, function, and felt resonance.

My hopes and dreams are with you, new ones entering the worlds of ideas and ways of living. My endearing thoughts are with you who have lived and worked for loved ones, now seeing the finality of being, that you may enlighten the unfolding paths of these new ones—as Roman geniuses drawn to guiding works, guiding futures.

In the end, what we speak of here—the Awakening Elements, CiPAE, Author Spaces, Agile, philosophies, paradigms, and methodologies—all of it, if followed to its source, converges into a single current: a recognition not of separation, but of shared essence. That current is Ubuntu. *I am because you are.*

This truth is beyond aspirational—it is ancestral. It is the power we have always carried, quietly waiting to be remembered.

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About the Author

As a boy, hours drifted away in the flickering black-and-white glow of the original Star Trek series. With few toys at hand, imagination became my greatest companion. The towering cottonwood tree just outside a ragged kitchen door served as a launchpad for wonder—its branches snapped and carved into makeshift starships. One became a handcrafted model of the Space Shuttle. These weren't just toys; they were vessels of possibility, bearing quiet dreams of exploration and a belief that life could be reshaped through curiosity alone. Beyond the technology, what lingered most—even to a child's mind—was the presence, the fluid grace in the way people worked, and the radical notion that ideas, not money, could be the true engine of human affairs.

English posed the greatest academic challenge, especially with my dyslexia gently unraveling the threads of cause and effect. Yet life reroutes. I earned a degree in Electrical Engineering in 1985, the start of a career rooted in logic and time—deciphering programming languages as a developer. From there, a half-century-long journey unfolded—translating languages both human and machine—eventually reshaping my linear engineering mind into that of a self-avowed artist.

One memory remains vivid: walking out of a university theatre after watching *The Terminator*, dazed and ignited. That spark led to early explorations in AI during a hands-on era brimming with potential. Between 1989 and 1993, I created the tools *NeuroKit* and *ET Neural Networks*—graphical software that opened neural networks to hobbyists, researchers, and pioneering technologists alike. With no internet to rely on, these tools traveled by sneakernet, carried on floppy disks to swap meets across the U.S. Some mementos from that time still remain: original 5¼" and 3.5" disks, and handwritten letters from fellow tinkerers. During what became known as the AI Winter, these tools may have quietly helped sustain the momentum of grassroots innovation and inquiry.

Regarding sustainability, I had the good fortune of listening to visiting speakers while working for four years as a developer at the Global Institute of Sustainability at Arizona State University in Tempe, Arizona. Although sustainability is not my primary background, it was heartening to be exposed to designing futures that embrace natural ways of living.

A turning point came on a Colorado farm, where I lived simply and sustainably for three years—surviving on just one gallon of water a day for tea, soups, washing dishes, mopping the floor, and two pints of heated water for a spray shower. It was a place of endless rolling grassy hills, a large pond, a tiny forest, and in the distance, a snow-topped mountain. Puffy evening clouds gave way to starlit nights and a fire pit glowing under the sky. In that quietude, something unexpected emerged: the discovery of *Conduiting Ambiances*—a space where the technical and the transcendent blurred. From this, a new identity gradually took shape through the years: that of a *Shaman Engineer*. What this truly means is still elusive, though now and then, its essence reveals itself in real life. That unfolding journey was first shared through a playfully penned book, *Sugar Skull Xmas en Mexico*, etched into the bell bottoms script.

Here we make our own toys—evolving together.
